

Mapleton City 24th of July Celebration Parade Guidelines

The Pioneer Day Parade is scheduled to begin at 9:00 AM Saturday, July 24.

This year's Theme:

"Days Gone By"

Line up for the parade will be in the Mapleton Junior High School parking lot located at 362 E. 1200 N at 8:00 am for floats and 8:30 am for children.

Any Mapleton resident, group, or organization is invited to participate as long as they adhere to the following Guidelines.

To be included in this year's parade you must **submit a parade Entry Form by July 4, 2010.**

Guidelines

- 1 Participants are strongly encouraged to follow the theme.
- 2 For safety reasons, candy or other items may not be thrown by parade participants along the route. They may be passed out to the crowd by people walking along the route. (Utah State Code section 41-6-114)
- 3 Squirting water from water hoses, squirt bottles or guns, surgical tubing, etc. is not allowed.
- 4 No ATVs are allowed, unless they are used to pull a float.
- 5 Vehicles of any type driven in the parade or pulling floats must be operated by adults at least 21 years of age.
- 6 All horse entries MUST provide their own "pooper scoopers" or they cannot participate. Children riding horses must be accompanied by an adult along the entire parade route.
- 7 Since the parade sponsor is The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, no political entries will be allowed other than current city officials or officers.
- 8 All participants MUST sign a *Waiver and Release of Damages* form and submit it to the parade committee prior to the parade.
- 9 Every parade entry requires adult supervision at all times to protect children that are participating in the parade from injuries that may occur from other entries, floats, and vehicle wheels.
- 10 Children participating in the parade must be supervised by an adult.
- 11 All those riding bicycles or scooters must wear a helmet and child riders must be supervised by at least two walking adults.
- 12 The parade starts at 9:00am sharp. Floats will begin lining up at 8:00am. All adult participants are to come at that time. Children are to come at 8:30. Drop off location for the Children is the Junior High east parking lot, next to the LDS Seminary building.
- 13 For their safety, children should remain in assembly areas on the grass near the parking lot until it is time to load them on the floats. Children waiting to load must be supervised by adults from their parade entry.
- 14 PLEASE REMEMBER that entries which are not received and approved by the deadline, entries that show up to the parade late, entries that do not have a signed waiver for each participant, and horse entries that do not have their own "pooper scoopers" WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE.
