Dear Bishops and Primary Presidents:

It is time again for the Mapleton Pioneer Day Parade. This letter will outline the procedures for the Parade portion of the celebration.

**The theme this year is “Days Gone By”.** Attached you will find a copy of the Parade Route, Guidelines, a Waiver and Release Form (which must be signed by a parent or guardian, 18 years of age or older, for **ALL** individuals participating in the parade, children and adults), as well as the Parade Entry Form which must be turned in for all groups wishing to participate in the parade (including ward entries).

Of course, all primaries are invited to enter the parade. Traditionally the Primary President is in charge of organizing the participation for their ward, but it may be assigned to someone else. The person responsible from your ward will need to make copies of the Waiver and Release Form and make sure each participant completes it ***prior*** to parade day. All forms should be collected by the Primary President. We will be collecting these forms the morning of the Parade.

Please announce in your ward bulletins/newsletter that any individual or groups are welcome to enter the parade as long as all rules and guidelines are strictly adhered to.

**All parade entry forms MUST be completed and returned on or before July 4<sup>th</sup>. Late entries will NOT be accepted.**

Once all the entry forms have been received, we will send you a map of the parade lineup and an Instruction Sheet.

The Parade begins at 9:00 a.m. sharp. Entries will begin lining up at 8:00 am. Primary Children must arrive at their designated parade line-up spot by 8:30am. Floats and participants must enter at Mapleton Jr. High parking lot at 1200 N. 400 E. Primary children need to be dropped off at the seminary building and wait in the grassy area until instructed by parade officials for them to be escorted to their lineup position by their primary leaders. When dropping off children for the parade, please use 400 North to 400 East to the Seminary building. You can also use 600 North to 400 East. **PLEASE DO NOT USE 1200 NORTH FROM MAIN TO DROP OFF CHILDREN!**
