Item 1: Mapleton City requests to amend the Non-Motorized Trails Element of Mapleton City's General Plan, including written policies and the Non-Motorized Trails Plan Map.

Cathy Jones would like to see a Horse Trail Head somewhere within the City. Tracy Padgett asked if they could show Clyde Park on the map. She also felt it would be helpful if they could show connectivity to Springville and Spanish Fork. The Committee would like a reference date added to the map, as well as to have the Key items listed in order by importance. A discussion took place in regards to the bike paths throughout the City that were listed on the map. The Committee would like to see a whinding asphalt trail on Highway 89 along the east side of the street. Cory Branch was asked to talk with UDOT in regards to easements and trails/paths along the Highway. The Committee Members would like a bike lane to be incorporated on Community Center Way (400 North) in front of the City Office Building. They would also like a bike lane stripped along north Main Street. Matt Brady was asked to talk with Springville about a bike path to their High School, when he meets with them in the future. They also wanted shoulder striping from 1600 North to Clyde Park on 800 West. Matt will check on the possibility of a bike path along either 400 East, 800 East, or 1200 East connecting to the school. Shoulder striping to be shown from Hobble Creek School east to 1200 East and south to Maple Street. The Committee would like a bike route on 2400 South toward Maple Mountain High School. The Trails Members were invited to attend the Transportation Committee Meeting on Thursday, April 2, 2009 at 6:00pm. The Committee Members were given the written policies for the General Plan Text in regards to Trails.

Chairwoman Padgett opened the Public Hearing. No comments were given and the Public Hearing was closed. The Committee would like an article put in the Newsletter about the status of trails/bike paths throughout the City. Matt was asked to take a picture of the Springville Bike Paths for the Transportation Committee. The Trails Sub-Committee decided to hold an additional meeting on Tuesday, March 17th, 2009 at 9:00am to discuss Eldon Taylor's Maple Glen Subdivision Trail, and to do a review of the map with the applicable changes, before it goes to the Transportation Committee.
