Item 1. Trails Sub-Committee Minutes – March 16, 2010.

Item 3. Mapleton City requests approval of a grant application concept report for funding of the proposed Historic Mapleton Lateral Canal Parkway Trail project, for submission to the Mountainland Association of Governments. The proposed concept report includes estimates for engineering, environmental work, title work, property acquisition, and construction funding, as well as a conceptual plan. The grant application is proposed to be sent to the City Council for approval

The Central Utah Water District stated at the March 23, 2010 Meeting, that they plan to run 16 feet of gravel along the canal trail area. Matt went over the grant application information for those in attendance. This proposal will go to City Council on Tuesday, April 20, 2010, after which it will be ready for submittal. Information to be added as to where the City's matching portion will come from. Parking lots need to be added to the proposal as well, which Matt will look into. It was discussed to team up with Springville City in regards to the continuance of the proposed trail. There is budgeting for undeveloped areas, but the City can require possible developers to accrue some of these costs. Matt will add in the trail head costs, so the number will be higher than currently being shown.

Item 4. Mapleton City requests to discuss the status of the draft Trails and Transportation Plan.

The draft plan goes to the Planning Commission on Thursday, April 22nd, and then on to City Council. Additional steps have been taken to publicize for these meetings, so that any citizens who want to be involved can be.

Item 5. The Mapleton City Trails Sub-Committee requests to discuss suggestions for possible new committee members.

At this time there were no additional names submitted or discussed.

Item 6. Mapleton City Trails-Sub Committee requests to discuss plans for a re-dedication ceremony for the new Maple Canyon Trail improvements.

It was discussed that Mayor Wall should dedicate the trail. Dedication starts at 6pm. Information went out in the April 2010 Newsletter, so that everyone who wants to attend is aware of the event. Tracy will present the Scout Members who took part in this with a certificate from the Forest Service, for the work they did on this trail project. The "Mapleton has Sole" challenge will start their portion of the project at approximately 6:20pm. An article will be put in the Mapleton Breeze and Springville Herald about the event some time this week. Tracy will coordinate with Sarah Flinders from the Forest Service, and the City Mayor.
