Items below are not necessarily in the order they appear.

Cory Branch to provide 24"x 36" drawings to Committee Members. Cathy Jones to provide email addresses to April Houser for those who are invited to attend the Trail's Sub-Committee Meetings. Next Trail's Sub-Committee Meeting to be held on Monday, July 14th at 9am.

Item 1. Mapleton Canal Parkway (next step, working with Preserve and Presidio developments, no trespassing, working with residents with concerns, fund raising, timeline).

The Transportation Committee, Planning Commission and City Council will be approving the letter to the Department of Interior by the 18th of June. Once this takes place the following things will need to happen:

1. Form SF-299 for the Bureau of Reclamation and the Department of Interior and CUWCD.
2. Inter-local Agreement and Parkway Use Agreements with the same.
3. Engineering and Surveying documentation.
4. Grants and Funding.
5. Final draft of Greenway and Trail Plan.
6. Easement Agreements/Legal contracts.

Signs are going to be posted by the CUWCD on the canal. There is a possibility that there will be walking access in this area, however motorized vehicles are prohibited. An article will be put in the July Newsletter giving citizens an update on the pursue of the Canal Parkway Trail.

Ann Tolley suggested that we look into getting bids from local Engineering Agencies regarding the cost for environmental and engineering studies to be done in regards to using the canal as a trail. Cory Branch will talk with Horrock's and RB&G Engineering to get an estimate on what

the cost may be to have these studies done.

It was discussed to put an article in the July Newsletter about the status of the Canal Parkway Trail. Cory did do an update for the City Council in a Staff Report that will be given to them with the letter to the Department of the Interior. Cory will look into what the water district wants for the contract, and will try to get the engineering drawings from the water district.

Item 2. Regional Trails Plan (connecting trails to Springville and Spanish Fork).

Tracy will find out when the next meeting date is, and get the items together for it. Matt Brady to show the Trail connection on the map from Spanish Fork, through Mapleton, to Springville. Cory Branch to work with Spanish Fork and Springville on trail connectivity.

Item 3. Update of Master Trails Plan.

The Trails Sub-Committee does not recommend giving the current easement along 1600 South back to the Preserve Development. They feel it needs to remain until a definite Trail access has been put into place. The Committee also asked as to where the trail parking would be in the amended Preserve Plat A? The Trails Sub-Committee will continue to look at 1600 south and Plat B of the Preserve for the best trail connection.

Rick Maingot to work with the Transportation Committee on possible bike paths from east to west looping around the City.

Item 4. Forest Service (National Trails Day, next work day June 28th from 8-noon).

There will be 3 Eagle Scout projects taking place on the trail. Those attending are asked to wear pants and sturdy shoes. Volunteers will be working on retaining walls, an addition creek passage way, and removal and replacement of the old fence.
