Chairman Padgett called the meeting to order at 9:10am.

Items below are not necessarily in the order they were heard.

Item 1. Trails Sub-Committee Minutes – August 9, 2010.

Motion: Member Padgett moved to approve the Trails Sub-Committee Minutes for August 9, 2010.

Second: Member Jones

Vote: Unanimous

Item 2. Mapleton City requests to discuss the status of an application for a grant through Mountainland Association of Governments for funding of the proposed Mapleton Lateral Canal Parkway Trail.

The grant funding would not be available until 2013. Staff would not recommend doing any work on this project at this time, since work done before the Grant is received will not be reimbursed. Even the title work would need to wait, since ownership of land could change between now and 2013. Matt went over the proposed Phase I plan for those in attendance, which will go from 1600 North south to Main Street. Phase II will go from Main Street to Highway 6, and 1600 North to the Hobble Creek Trail in Springville. Phase II granting funding will be applied for in 2012. The City is hoping to do the project in 2 Phases. Springville will not be involved in Phase I, but may be in Phase II.

Matt went over the Trails Map in regarding to the south end of the City, as well as the areas that could possibly annexed in the future. Discussion took place about the other future trails the City would like to obtain as land is developed along the hillside in the future. Trail head areas were also discussed. Possible Trails Heads/Parking Stalls could be 1600 South – 4 stalls; Preserve B – 4 stalls; Mapleton Village – 10 stalls, with restroom/water; EBCo – Horse Trailer Parking, restroom/water; Maple Canyon – 12 stalls, and possible restrooms/water; Freedom Vista – 6 stalls; 1600 North – 12 stalls, with restroom/water; Main Street – 10 Stalls; Boggus development – 10 stalls; Smoot – 4 stalls. Tracy would like to see some parking lot areas that would be able to hold parking for horse trailers, etc. At some point the City would like to tie into the Spanish Fork trail that goes up the Canyon.

Item 3. Update on 1600 South Trail design project (BYU Engineering Student Project).

Matt spoke with the BYU Professor over this project, and they plan to start working on the design this week. In about a month we should have a plan drawn up and submitted to the City. It was discussed that the Trails Sub-Committee would be notified when a meeting takes place between Staff and BYU. The plan is to take the proposal to the City Council in January 2011. The Committee would like to have the property owners in this area notified when this item is going before the City Council. They would also like the Planning Commission to be notified of this item. Staff was asked to check in to possible funding for this project.

Item 4. New MAG Utah County Trails Map / New Mapleton City Trails Map.

Matt handed out a map that MAG did showing all of the trails throughout Utah County. These maps are available for anyone. Matt has designed a Trails Map for Mapleton City, showing all of the current trails throughout the City.

Item 5. Update on funds from the Mapleton Moonlight Half Marathon.

Currently there is about \$14,000 in the Moonlight fund, which includes profits made in 2009 and 2010. It is assumed that in future years the run should profit about \$10,000 per year. These funds could possibly be used as part of the MAG matching grant portion the City will be required to do with the Mapleton Lateral Canal Parkway Trail. The run is scheduled to take place in 2011 on Friday, August 12th.
