Member Pratt thought that the City required the Animal Hospital on Highway 89 to install 400 North - staff was directed to look into this further. The Committee recommended that 400 North be a collector street from Main Street to Highway 89. The Committee wants to emphasize the need for another east-west exit to Mapleton between Slant Road and Springville's 1600 South. Ways to limit cul-de-sacs was also discussed. The Committee feels that 8% street grades should be the maximum allowed in the plan.
